both power of attorney for extrajudicial representation of all kinds and power of attorney for all proceedings in all instances. This power of attorney extends in particular to the following powers:

1. Extrajudicial representation, assertion of claims against injuring parties, vehicle owners and their insurers and inspection of files
2. Establishment and cancellation of contractual relationships and submission and receipt of unilateral declarations of intent (e.g. terminations)
3. Representation in private and statutory arbitration proceedings
4. Litigation (including according to Sec. 81ff. of the Code of Civil Procedure, ZPO)
5. Filing applications in divorce and follow-up matters, concluding agreements on the consequences of divorce and filing applications for pension and other pension information
6. Representation and defense in criminal and fine matters (Sec. 302, 374 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, StPO) including the preliminary proceedings as well as (in the event of absence) representation according to Sec. 411 para. 2 StPO and with express authorization also according to Sec. 233 para. 1, 234 StPO and position of criminal and other applications permitted under the Code of Criminal Procedure
7. In the case of applications according to the law on compensation for criminal prosecution measures, the power of attorney also applies to the amount procedure
8. Representation before administrative, social and financial authorities and courts
9. Representation before the labor courts
10. Settlement of legal disputes or out-of-court negotiations through settlement, other agreement, waiver or acknowledgment
11. Filing and withdrawing legal remedies and waiving them
12. Receiving and arranging deliveries and other communications
13. All subsidiary and follow-up procedures, e.g. arrest and injunction, fixing of costs, foreclosure, including the special procedures resulting therefrom, insolvency, foreclosure, receivership and deposit
14. Receipt of the costs, money and other documents to be reimbursed by the opponent, the judicial treasury or other bodies
15. Transfer of power of attorney in whole or in part to others
